Pomona City Council Seeks Pomona Residents Interested in Serving on a City Commission

POMONA, CA (November 15, 2018) – If you have a strong interest in the community and have the ability to give generously of your time, why not apply to serve on a City Board or Commission? Commissioners and Board Members have an opportunity to make a difference in the community by providing recommendations to the City Council. Commissioners serve on a volunteer basis and are appointed by the City Council. Anyone who is a resident of Pomona and is interested in serving on a Commission may obtain an application from the City Clerk's Office or on the City's website at www.ci.pomona.ca.us.

The City of Pomona is seeking individuals to be considered for the following vacancies or reappointments following the November 2018 General Municipal Election:

- **Three (3) openings on the Board of Library Trustees.** The Board of Library Trustees oversees the management and operations of the Pomona Public Library. The Library Board may solicit funds for the sole benefit of the Library, subject to the City Council's approval. The Board meets on the third Wednesday of every month at 5:00 p.m. in the Library Public Conference Room.
- **Three (3) openings on the Board of Parking Place Commissioners (VPD).** The Commissioners represent the downtown business community in its effort to maintain and improve the parking quality for that area. The commission meets on the second Thursday of the month at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
- **Three (3) openings on the Community Life Commission.** The purpose of this commission is to foster better City/Citizen relations through its responsibility in the area of human relations/services. The commission meets on the fourth Tuesday of the month, at 6:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
- **Three (3) openings on the Cultural Arts Commission.** The Cultural Arts Commission promotes the arts and coordinates cultural activities within the City including activities relating to the community's artistic and cultural heritage of the City. The commission also designates historical monuments in the City. The commission meets the 4th Monday of the month at 5:30 p.m. in the City Council Closed Session Room.
- **Three (3) openings on the Historic Preservation Commission.** The Historic Preservation Commission recommends historic landmark designation, application, enforcement, and education of the community. The commission meets the 1st Wednesday of the month at 7:00 p.m. in the City Council Chambers.
- **Three (3) openings on the Parks and Recreation Commission.** The Commission serves as an advisory body in all matters pertaining to City parks, street trees and public recreation. The commission meets on the 3rd Thursday of every other month at 6:00 p.m. at various City community centers.
