Tri-City Mental Health Authority (Tri-City) Seeks Pomona, Claremont, and La Verne Residents Interested in Serving on Tri-City's Mental Health Commission (MHC)

February 14, 2018 – If you have a strong interest in the community and the ability to contribute some of your time, please apply to serve on the Mental Health Commission. MHC is an advisory body to the Governing Board and it has no policy or budget authority. Commissioners have an opportunity to make a difference in the community by providing recommendations to the Tri-City Governing Board and the Executive Director. Commissioners serve on a volunteer basis and are appointed by the Governing Board. Anyone who is interested in serving, and wants to become an advocate for mental health, must reside or work within the Tri-City catchment area: Claremont, Pomona, or La Verne. The MHC Regular Meetings are held the 2nd Tuesday of the month; except in August when no meetings are held, and in May & December when they meet on the 3rd Wednesday of the month in a joint meeting with the Governing Board.
