- ✓ Coupons
- ✓ Envelopes
- ✓ Glass bottles, jars
- ✓ Glass cosmetic bottles
- ✓ Junk mail
- ✓ Laundry bottles
- ✓ Magazines/catalogs
- ✓ Newspaper
- ✓ Paper
- ✓ Paper tubes

Non-Acceptable Items

Recycling the correct materials adds to the success of your recycling program. Remember to avoid putting the following materials in the Recycling container.

- ✗ Bag with trash
- ✗ Ceramic dishware
- ✗ Contaminated rags
- ✗ Food/food soiled paper products*
- ✗ Glass dishware
- ✗ Green waste/wood
- ✗ Metal wire clothes hangers
- ✗ Non-recyclable foam
- ✗ Pet food bags
- ✗ Pizza boxes
- ✗ Rubber hoses
- ✗ Wax covered cardboard boxes
- ✗ Tarps
- ✗ Textiles (clothing, bedding, etc.)
