Caltrans Coordinates 90-Day Closure of Two Ramps on I-10 in West Covina With Opening of Three Repaved Ramps

WEST COVINA — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces it will close two ramps for 90 days for pavement rehabilitation on Interstate 10 (San Bernardino Freeway) in West Covina on Tuesday, Feb. 18, as part of the I-10 High Occupancy Vehicle Lane Construction Project. In coordination with the closures, three repaved ramps will open the same day.

90-Day Closures Beginning Feb. 18:

- **Grand Ave. on-ramp to eastbound I-10**
- **Holt Ave. straight on-ramp to eastbound I-10**



Three Repaved Ramps Open Feb. 18:

- **NB/SB Barranca St. on-ramp to eastbound I-10**
- **Eastbound I-10 off-ramp to NB/SB Holt Ave.**
- **SB Holt Ave on-ramp to eastbound I-10**
