As of January 1st, 2017, the Building and Safety Division began enforcement of the 2016 State Building Codes for all new residential and non-residential construction projects. Projects submitted after January 1st, 2017, shall comply with the new codes.

Local Design Criteria: (ASCE7-10)

Seismic Design: Category 'D', 'E' or 'F' as determined by USGS Maps and CBC Chapter 16

Wind: (ASCE7-10)

Rainfall: 2" /hr.

Climate Zone: 9

Flood Zone: D and X

Risk Category I: 100mph, Exposure 'C'

Risk Category II: 110 mph, Exposure 'C'

Risk Category III and IV: 120 mph, Exposure 'C'

These codes are based upon the 2015 International Building Code, 2014 National Electrical Code, 2015 Uniform Mechanical Code, 2015 Uniform Plumbing Code, and 2015 International Fire Code adopted by the State of California Building Standards Commission (<http://www.bsc.ca.gov/>), to provide for the safety and welfare of Californians through the implementation of the latest technology, materials, engineering, and construction methods.
