In 2014-2015, Pomona Homeless Services and Pomona Homeless Outreach assisted 434 "literally" homeless people, including 310 adults and 124 children. As a result of these efforts:

- 109 homeless Pomonans moved from the streets to permanent housing: an apartment or room for rent;
- 149 homeless Pomonans moved from the streets to temporary housing: shelter, transitional housing, friends/family; and
- 2 homeless Pomonans moved to a residential substance abuse facility.
