

Quiet Zone

The Pomona Quiet Zone officially went into operation on Monday, September 24, 2007. The Quiet Zone is from San Antonio Avenue to Hamilton Boulevard, along the First Street Corridor. All trains are prohibited from using horns unless an engineer feels an emergency exists that threatens human or animal injury or property damage. It is very important to stay clear of the railroad right-of-way and never to use the tracks as a path or walkway. Not only will this cause the engineer to blow the horn, it is also dangerous and illegal.
