

RECYCLE YOUR USED TIRES

First Saturday of Every Month



City of Pomona residents are encouraged to bring their used tires to the location listed below on the first Saturday of each month, beginning September 1, 2007. Used tires will be accepted and recycled free of charge to residents. This program is funded by a grant from the California Integrated Waste Management Board (CIWMB). The program will continue until grant funds are expended.

Reasons to recycle your used tires-

WASTE- Approximately 10 million waste tires are generated each year in Los Angeles County alone.

HEALTH- Improper discarded waste tires are an ideal breeding ground and habitat for rodents and mosquitoes, which may carry and spread diseases.

HAZARD- Tire stockpiles is a fire hazard that can cause air, water, and soil pollution.

Recycle your waste tires for beneficial uses-

FUEL- An alternate source of fuel for cement kilns and power plants.

SURFACES- Rubberized asphalt concrete (RAC) is used in roadway construction and resurfacing.

STRUCTUAL SUPPORT- In engineering applications for impervious cover or cap material at landfills, waste containment, and erosion protection on steep slopes and retaining walls.

PADDING- Crumb rubber applications include carpet padding, tree rings, and floor mats.

RESTRICTIONS-

- Only used **passenger** vehicle tires from City of Pomona residents will be accepted. Proof of residence required.
- No rims, truck tires, or tires from commercial establishments will be accepted.
- No more than 10 tires per event per resident will be accepted.
